<u>Transfer Station Rules:</u> You must have proper identification and be an Exeter resident (valid driver's license) or property owner (tax bill).

Hours of Operation:

Tuesday: 9:00 a.m. until 2:30 p.m. Thursday: 1:00a.m. until 4:00 p.m. Saturday: 9:00 a.m. until 2:30 p.m.

Extended Hours (Oct 15 thru Dec 15):

Saturday: 8:00 a.m. until 2:30 p.m. Sunday: 12:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m.

Directions: From the bandstand head out of downtown on Front Street (Rte 111 changes to Kingston Road). Turn right onto Cross Road. Transfer Station will be approx. ¼ mile on the left. **Stop for Attendant,** attendant must check vehicles and bags that they are hazardous waste free. Permits, bags and stickers are **not** sold at the Transfer Station.

Transfer Station Permit Prices:

Calendar Year \$10.00 5 Day Pass \$5.00

Free leaf and grass compost to residents.

Items that can be dropped off at NO COST:

- Used Oil place in clear or semi-clear container with tight fitting lid such as plastic milk jug & labeled "Used Oil" oil cannot be mixed with any other waste, including gasoline and/or antifreeze
- Leaves & Grass must be in biodegradable paper bags (no plastic bags)
- Christmas Trees Tinsel, lights and ornaments removed
- Books, videos, CD's, & DVD's
- Clothes & Shoes
- Calculator & Cell phones

TO KEEP COSTS LOW – PLEASE PLACE ITEMS IN APPROPRIATE CONTAINERS

A <u>Transfer Station Permit</u> is required for disposal of certain items. The permit can be purchased at the Town Clerk's. You must show proof of residency or property ownership. License plate number is required for calendar year permit. It shall be *affixed* to the driver's side, lower corner of vehicle's windshield.

ITEMS REQUIRING A TRANSFER STATION PERMIT:

White Goods (non Refrigerant) appliances including washers, dryers, dishwashers, stoves, water heaters, etc.)

Metals – two metal containers

- **Ferrous:** steel, iron, wrought iron, bicycles, metal lawn furniture, metal barbecue grills, etc. (lawn mowers, snow blowers & other equip. O*il and gas must be removed.)*
- Non Ferrous: aluminum, copper, brass, etc.

<u>Wood, brush, wood pallets</u> – not to be larger than 4ft. in length, painted, stained or pressure treated wood, particle board, T-111 or plywood. <u>Wood Chips are free</u> to residents with proper ID or permit.

Ash - wood stove and coal ash

<u>Batteries</u> – the following batteries should be taken to the Transfer Station or Household Hazardous Waste Collection; Lithium, Button Cell, Nickel-Cadmium (Ni-Cd), Nickel Metal Hydride (Ni-MH), Lithium Ion (Li-Ion), small sealed lead acid (Pb) less than 2 lbs in weight and automobile batteries with terminals duct taped (check- some auto/parts may pay small amount for auto batteries)

<u>Mercury Disposal</u> - All products containing mercury are banned from landfills and incinerators. Items that may contain mercury and should be taken to the <u>Transfer Station</u> include:

- > Thermometers, thermostats, electrical switches, mercury button cell batteries and fluorescent light bulbs including compact fluorescent bulbs.
- Items containing mercury can also be taken to the Household Hazardous Waste Collection Day, held the 1st Saturday in October.
- Arjay's Ace Hardware accepts a limited number of fluorescent bulbs and mercury containing thermostats, contact store for more information.

Propane or Gas Tanks - 20lbs. or less.

<u>Recyclable Materials</u> – moving and other large boxes, newspaper, magazines and other paper products, glass food and beverage containers, aluminum, steel and tin cans, aluminum foil, plastic food and beverage containers #1 thru #7. **NO PLASTIC BAGS OR STYROFOAM**

<u>Household Trash</u> – must be in "Town of Exeter" blue bags. Only household trash in Exeter blue bags is accepted in the regular dumpsters.

ITEMS REQUIRING AN ELECTRONIC STICKER ONLY:

Electronic Waste Stickers must be purchased at Town Clerk's, 10 Front Street, Monday thru Friday; 8AM to 4:00PM

Electronic Waste: Electronics contain lead and a variety of other hazardous materials. Electronic items require a \$10 Electronic Waste Sticker, but do *not* need a Transfer Station Permit. Electronic waste includes, but not limited to:

- Computers monitor, hard drive, printer, laptop, battery pack; each piece requires a separate sticker
- Televisions
- Copy machines, Fax Machines, Scanners
- Microwave Ovens
- Stereos, Radios, DVD & VCR players
- Toaster Ovens, Coffee Makers, Digital Alarm Clocks
- Vacuum Cleaners, Electronic Scales, Fans





THE FOLLOWING ITEMS REQUIRE A STICKER AND A TRANSFER STATION PERMIT:

Both permits must be purchased at the Town Clerk, 10 Front Street, Monday thru Friday – 8:15AM to 4:00PM

Refrigerant (CFCs/Freon) Appliances:

Non-metal parts (bins, shelves) must be removed and placed in "Exeter" blue trash bags.

Requires a \$7 Refrigerant Appliance Sticker & Transfer Station Permit.

- Refrigerators (doors removed)
- Freezers (doors removed)
- Air Conditioners
- Water Coolers
- Dehumidifiers

Construction Debris: (NO LIQUIDS or ASBESTOS)

A Transfer Station permit will be needed to dispose of construction debris.

"Town of Exeter – Orange Bag and Sticker" A "Pay-as-you-Throw system has been established to provide residents a way to dispose small quantities of construction debris. This program allows Exeter residents to dispose items such as drywall, shingles, insulation & paint cans (paint must be solid with lids removed - open can to dry out or add kitty litter to make solid) and placed in an "Orange Bag". Items such as doors, windows, toilets, sinks, and bundled wood or carpet can use an approved "Orange Sticker".

Cost is \$6.00 per bag and \$6.00 per sticker. Construction Debris Bags and Stickers can be purchased at the Town Clerk's, 10 Front St, Monday thru Friday; 8AM to 4:00PM. Bags and stickers may also be purchased at Arjay's Ace Hardware.

ITEMS THAT CANNOT BE ACCEPTED AT TRANSFER STATION:

The Town of Raymond has a Transfer Station that accepts materials for a fee. www.raymondnh.gov/publicworks/waste.php Check your local newspaper and/or phone book for trash haulers.

- > Bulky Waste (one item per week with sticker, placed at curbside on regular trash day)
- ➤ Household Hazardous Waste (Household Hazardous Waste Collection Day is held the 1st Saturday in October)
- > Tires (Raymond Transfer Station \$5 & up)
- > Antifreeze, Brake Fluid or other Auto Chemicals (Dispose at Household Hazardous Waste Collection Day)
- > ASBESTOS
- > Sharps/Syringes
- > Pharmaceuticals
