We will not pursue the purchase of new tables. The present ones are fairly new and in good condition. Folding Redental Tables are very expensive and, when folded, take up too much room.

Jodi has revised the COA Bylaws, and will re-revise to be discussed at the June meeting.

Jodi and Sandy went to the State Committee on Ageing meeting which they found very informative, especially the ServiceLink group. They hope to have a representative speak to us in June.
