Peg reported that our C.D., due in December, was \$1796.35 and the money market \$1433.41.

Alma said that the Grange is waiting for an official letter from the Town for their donation to buy new arm chairs for the senior center. Russ thought that the request had been sent, but he would check on it and have it resend if necessary.

Mike has a brochure for the type of chair that is needed. The price is \$35.00 per chair with free shipping if over 50 chairs are ordered. The estimated cost would be between \$1,00.00, and \$2,00.00.

The Grange would write a check to the town which would be deposited in the COA account.

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Mike said that the team will run out of taxi tickets before the end of the year and will not be funded again until January. The COA will send a letter to the selectmen requesting that money from the transportation fund be used to make more money available for tickets. Mike and Alma will take care of this.

Rob and Patty said that the Senior Center has been busy, and that the vans give several rides a day.
