**2). Budget Impact of Lamprey Healthcare in Transportation Fund**

Town Office Staff provided current, as of Nov.30,  
Performance Measures-Town Clerk- Transportation Improvement Fund & Account Balances-  
Finance Dept.-05 Accounts. All accounts are operating pretty much as expected including  
anticipated growth in taxi-voucher use. Committee voted to send a Letter to the Selectmen  
with the following recommendation for quarterly disbursement of funds based on the  
following annual service requests.

T.A.S.C.....	\$16,000.00
R.N.M.O.W.....	\$12,000.00
Taxi Vouchers.....	\$7,500.00
Lamprey Health Van/Bus.....	\$6,000.00
Total.....	\$41,500.00, with any funds over & above those currently committed be retained for a future 2013 or 2014 summer service pilot program.

**4). Seacoast Region Service Coordination Program**

Exeter is a member of the seacoast regional transportation committee, A.C.T., Alliance for  
Community Transportation. There are 10 regions within New Hampshire and the Seacoast  
Region includes portions of Eastern Rockingham, Stafford and Southern Carroll counties.  
This year A.C.T. will be the first in the state to incorporate a software system that coordinates  
ride requests, drivers, appropriate vehicles with destinations. Health care providers can  
efficiently plan appointments for dialysis, chemo-therapy, pain clinics, physical & mental  
therapy, annual check-ups and interventional spine therapy treatments.
