Public Hearings Notice
Community Development Block Grant Project

The Exeter Board of Selectmen will hold three consecutive Public Hearings on Tuesday, January 21, 2014 at 7:00pm in the Nowak Room at the Town Offices, 10 Front Street, Exeter, New Hampshire for a proposed Community Development Block Grant application to the New Hampshire Community Development Finance Authority (NHCDFA). Community Development Block Grant funds are available to municipalities through the NH Community Development Finance Authority. Up to \$500,000 annually is available on a competitive basis for Public Facility and Housing Projects, up to \$500,000 for Economic Development Projects, and up to \$350,000 for Emergency Activities that directly benefit low and moderate income persons. Up to \$12,000 per study is available for Planning Grants. The purpose of the hearings are public comment on the following:

1. A proposed Implementation Community Development Block Grant application to the Community Development Finance Authority for up to \$500,000 in Community Development Block Grant funds. The funds will finance tying the water and septic system into the municipal systems to remedy issues at Icey Hill Cooperative, a 15 unit manufactured housing park located at 55 Deep Meadows in Exeter. The majority of the residences are low and moderate income households.
2. Housing and Community Development Plan,
3. And the Residential Antidisplacement and Relocation Assistance Plan.
