



FEMA Flood Map Revision Public Information Session

Following removal of the Great Dam on the Exeter River in 2016, the Town of Exeter has contracted a consultant, VHB, to revise Flood Insurance Rate Maps (FIRMs) via a Letter of Map Revision (LOMR) through the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA). The LOMR will update flood risk maps for segments of the Exeter and Little Rivers affected by the dam removal.

Representatives from VHB and Exeter Public Works Department will host a public information session on Thursday, May 10 at the Exeter High School Auditorium to provide information on the LOMR process and how it affects residents of Exeter. The information session will include:

- **Full-size printed maps of revised flood risk for public viewing**
- **Summary of flood mapping changes along the Exeter and Little Rivers**
- **Schedule and milestones for the FEMA map revision process**
- **Explanation of FEMA flood map terms and acronyms**
- **Discussion of Flood Insurance requirements**
