The Case for a New Police Station/Fire Substation

The Police and Fire Departments have outgrown their current 1978 Public Safety Complex creating multiple problems.

Police Department Problems:

Inadequate workspace

- Overcrowded workstations in hallways.
- No space for confidential interviews.
- No training or meeting space.
- Not enough space for equipment to be stored, cleaned, or charged.
- Booking room cramped with necessary technology for finger printing, etc.
- Inadequate toilet facilities; no public restroom.

Liability due to lack of safety and security

- Evidence room maxed-out.
- Records stored in cells and unsecured storage shed.
- No victim/witness privacy.
- IT server for all of town's computer servers and equipment lacks fire suppression and roof leaks.
- Parking lot unsecured officers threatened; citizens have filmed vehicle and building interiors.
- Passage of prisoners through spaces cramped with workstations, tools, and gun cleaning.
- Lobby not secured.
- Not ADA compliant.

Fire Department Major Problem:

• Slow response times to area northwest of railroad tracks.

No new PD or FD staff required.

No major renovations to current building to accommodate FD.

New building will be energy efficient and net zero ready.

New building will solve above needs for space, safety, and security.
