

EXETER E-911 COMMITTEE

MINUTES

September 15, 2026

Building Inspector Doug Eastman called the meeting to order at 8:35 A.M. on the above date in the Wheelwright Room at the Exeter Town Office.

STAFF PRESENT: Deputy Fire Chief Jason Fritz, Lt Devin West, Building Inspector Doug Eastman, Town Planner Dave Sharples, GIS Coordinator Linda Burbank, and Select Board Representative Niko Papakonstantis.

1. Review and approval of Minutes: August 4th, 2026

David Sharples moved to approve the minutes of August 4th, 2026 as presented; second by Jason Fritz. VOTE: Unanimous.

2. Updates from the August 4th Meeting

- The changes at Westside Drive were approved by the Selectboard.
- Still waiting on John O'Neil for road names for the 5 Brentwood project.
- The NH DOT Fuel Island addressing has been completed
- The new road at Riverwoods still needs Selectboard approval

3. Addresses needing changes

- *47 (residential) and 47 A (Riverside Church) Hampton Road: The residential address will remain as is. The church will be assigned a new address at King's Court. Jason will look into what number should be assigned.*
- *7 Prospect Street. The former building has been torn down, and a new duplex has been built. New address will be 7 Prospect Street and 9 Prospect Street.*
- *57 Portsmouth Ave is now 6 units. Lettering will begin on the southern corner on Portsmouth Ave as A, B and C. The other side will also begin in the southern corner with D, E, and F.*
- *137 R Water Street. A conversation took place regarding the numbering for lower Water Street. A suggestion of a new name for the street was not favorable within the committee. Jason Fritz noted that emergency vehicles don't have any access to get to the location. He also added he did not care for "R" and suggested the committee investigate "b" for the basement level. Jason will research it further.*

The next regular meeting of the Committee will be Tuesday, October 6th, 2026 at 8:15 AM in the Wheelwright Room.

There being no further business to be addressed, Niko Papakonstantis moved to adjourn; seconded by Dave Sharples. VOTE: Unanimous. The meeting was adjourned at 9:05 A.M.
