Deputy Fire Chief Jason Fritz called the meeting to order at 9:00 A.M. on the above date in the Nowak Room at the Exeter Town Office.

STAFF PRESENT: Deputy Fire Chief Jason Fritz, Police Lieutenant Devin West, Building Inspector Doug Eastman, Town Planner Dave Sharples and Select Board Representative Niko Papakonstantis.

PUBLIC PRESENT:

1. Riverwoods Request for New Address for Maintenance Building

The Committee discussed Riverwoods' request to assign a separate address to its maintenance building so that maintenance deliveries would no longer be directed to the main building at 6 Timber Lane. The proposed address was **8 Timber Lane**.

Jason Fritz noted that emergency responders have had trouble locating buildings on the Riverwoods campus, and members discussed whether the request should be considered as part of a comprehensive review of addressing throughout the campus and, potentially, town-wide. Dave Sharples emphasized the importance of addressing the issue consistently with the Town's addressing ordinance rather than on a case-by-case basis. Members also discussed the scope, cost, and public outreach that would be required for a broader renumbering effort.

The Committee agreed that assigning **8 Timber Lane** could serve as a temporary solution but ultimately voted to postpone action pending further discussion.

**Motion:** Niko Papakonstantis moved to table the discussion and invite a representative from Riverwoods to attend the next meeting. Jason Fritz seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

The Committee scheduled its next meeting for July 7, 2026, at 8:30 a.m.

2. **20 Beech Hill Update**

The residents brought names, do not want to follow the ordinance. Jason feels we should move forward as there have been 6 to 8 calls since the last meeting. He noted that the state agrees it is two roads. Jason would like to move forward and # the houses appropriately. Dave feels the whole.

3. **75 Portsmouth Ave update**

Doug updated the committee with changes to 75 Portsmouth Ave. The business in the strip mall, Margarita's through Smash Burger, will keep the 75 Portsmouth Ave address, while the

stand alone building that was once Rite Aid will become 71 Portsmouth Ave. The three units will be numbered 101, 102, 103. Jason will bring the voluntary change of address form to the property.

#### **4. 16 Haze Park**

An email was received from NH 911 stating there was a call to 16 Haze Park, however, the E911 system did not recognize the address.

Jason Fritz motioned to make the addition of 16 Haze Road to the E911 map. Niko Papakonstantis seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

#### **5. Patrol Shed, 249 Epping Road**

The State is requesting an E911 address for the fuel island at the Patrol Shed located at 253 Epping Rd. The committee determined that the fuel shed would be 251 Epping Road.

Jason Fritz motioned to make the addition of 251 Epping Road as the official address of the fuel island. Dave Sharple second the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

***There being no further business to be addressed, Doug Eastman moved to adjourn; seconded by Niko Papakonstantis. VOTE: Unanimous. The meeting was adjourned at 9:40 A.M.***
