ONGOING BUSINESS:

LED Streetlight Conversion: Jennifer Perry has been working with JB and Steve from Affinity of Dover on modeling and shared a spreadsheet. Discussion took most of the hour. The numbers indicate a 5-year payback. Would like to get closer to a 3- year payback. Agreed to move up the CHIP to possible execution in 2019 if she can get the numbers to work with Unitil. Jennifer will ask Durham if they installed "smart" lights. Additional significant savings in installation and efficiencies could be had if we invest in smart & dimmable now instead of retro-fit. Renay will liaise with NHSEA re tariff.
