Virtual Public Educational events:

NDEW Oct 4th Exeter TV filmed a 15-min video of Renay and Amy talking about EV's, Exeter 2020 stats, and chargers. A local Tesla owner gave a tour of his car. We will link this to your website as well.

Workshops: Many of us attended Exeter Resource Planner Kristin Murphy's CAPE, etc cross-committees workshop. Felt it was beneficial, and would do more. The annual Local Energy Solutions (LES) Conference is virtual this year and is Oct 29 & 30.

Community Choice Power: Cliff and Lew wrote a letter to the PUC which we all agreed to sign. Julie said to add the Office of the Consumer Advocate as an addressee as well. Our letter is addition to the one from the northern coalition (Clifton Below, et al.) that has more technical details. PUC is currently writing the regulations that would enable the recent legislation to begin. The northern coalition feels PUC may create burdens for the transition, which would make the energy rate less competitive. Project is stalled at the moment while the PUC speaks with stakeholders. Lew and Cliff go on those calls.

Sustainability Officer Update: Dave Sharples relayed that he went before the select board last week to introduce a solar array at the landfill. He will issue RFP this week. Renay asked how Energy Cmte could begin a collaboration with any dept looking to buy a new vehicle – could it be a hybrid or EV? Renay & Dave will talk on the phone. Cliff said a place to start would be to work an EVC into the next CIP to lay the groundwork for getting more EV's in the town fleet. Dave relayed from Russ: our energy contract has one more year left, but that the vendor is offering a discount if we lock in now.6.999. Cliff said that would not interfere with a CPA.
