Funding is provided quickly, with no red tape, to the unpaid vendor or service provider. 100% of donations go directly back to the community with board members absorbing administrative costs.

Brief Detailed description of how the money will be specifically utilized for Exeter residents: WGS will provide Exeter residents in need of short term financial assistance with the financial assistance needed in the form of direct payment to the unpaid vendor. Expenses paid include food, gas, rent, auto, utilities, medical + dental needs, academics and camps, child care, and other expenses that when paid, help the family prevent a further downward debt spiral.

Womenade of Greater Squamscott (WofGS) is a non-profit 501c3, organized in 2005 to provide local NH seacoast women, families and individuals with short-term financial assistance, in a dignified way, not readily available through other resources. Anonymous requests are received from community sources such as town welfare offices, school nurses, hospice, social service organizations, churches, doctors and more. The requests are reviewed by our board members and if approved, a payment is quickly made directly to the unpaid vendor. By providing funding in this way, we hope to stop a downward debt spiral for the families in need.

The 2022 Town of Exeter grant of \$4,000 was put to immediate use within Exeter. In 2022, WofGS helped about 60 Exeter women, men, families, and elderly with rent, security deposits, heat, electricity, food, auto repairs and registrations, medical and dental needs, clothing, gas, academics, camps, and other expenses totaling over \$43,646 in financial assistance, plus \$4,000 in food gift cards that were distributed with holiday baskets through EHS and CMS. This year, through 7/15/22, WofGS has assisted 43 Exeter families with over \$34,000.

WofGS would use the \$4,000 2024 grant funds to help Exeter families, the elderly, and single parents with the same financial needs we have been providing for 18 years. 100% of donations received go directly back to the community with board members absorbing administrative and operating costs.
