Organization's Mission Statement and Statement of Grant Purpose (e.g. This grant will be used...):

Founded in 1987, New Generation's mission is to break the cycle of homelessness for local mothers and children, by providing them with a safe space and comprehensive services, building a path to housing stability and self-sufficient futures. Since its inception, New Generation has helped more than 1,900 pregnant women, single mothers, and children facing homelessness.

This grant will support program expenses, including:

- Safe Shelter: Provides shelter, food, parenting classes, financial empowerment counseling, case management, and referrals to core services to pregnant women and mothers of young children facing homelessness.
- Transitional Housing: Temporary housing for up to 24 months, assisting women and children who need
 additional space due to the size of their family. Food, parenting classes, financial empowerment counseling,
 case management, and referrals to core services are also available.
- Aftercare/Stabilization Services: Individual case management, parenting sessions, financial empowerment counseling, and referral to other core services to help clients who have moved out of New Generation maintain stable housing and meaningful employment.
- Second Generation Thrift Shop operations: Provides affordable clothing, home goods, and furniture to lowincome Exeter-area residents.

Brief Detailed description of how the money will be specifically utilized for Exeter residents:

The New Generation shelter welcomes mothers and children who are experiencing homelessness and including families from Exeter.

Through post-residence Stabilization Services, New Generation can serve families who have transitioned out of homelessness and are currently living in Exeter. Staff work with the Exeter Housing Authority, landlords, and other housing providers to find affordable housing for resident families who desire to move to Exeter.

Additionally, the thrift shop offers access to affordable clothing, home goods, and furniture to all low-income families living in the Exeter area.

* The Program Review Committee of the NH Catholic Charities Board evaluates each program, reviewing content and outcomes annually. The Finance Committee reviews and approves the budget for the New Hampshire Food Bank separately, and monitors performance toward goals throughout the year. Based on the recommendations of the committees, the programs are approved by the Board and funded in the current fiscal year's budget cycle. This funding is 100% generated by the New Hampshire Food Bank.

The President and CEO of New Hampshire Catholic Charities is authorized by the Board of Trustees to conduct the business of the organization, including all human service program activities.

Narrative

Program Overview

Founded in 1987, New Generation, a flagship program of Catholic Charities New Hampshire, is a safe, family-oriented shelter for pregnant women and mothers with children who are experiencing homelessness due to domestic violence, financial hardship, substance use disorder and other mental health challenges, among other issues. Since its inception, New Generation has helped more than 1,900 women and children find stable housing and access case management to help them from homelessness into independent living and self-sufficiency.

Catholic Charities New Hampshire is a human services organization, established in 1945, with a mission to provide quality services that heal, comfort, and empower the poor and vulnerable. Services are available to anyone in New Hampshire regardless of their race, color, religion (creed), gender, gender expression, age, national origin (ancestry), disability, marital status, sexual orientation, military status, or ability to pay. Today, Catholic Charities' trained professionals, supported by dedicated volunteers, offer a dynamic array of services that engage more than 146,000 people throughout NH each year.

Program Changes and Highlights

Key highlights from 2024:

- 6,115 total shelter nights.
- 64 mothers and 106 children served at the shelter and in Aftercare.
- 1,202 total client contacts.
- 92% of clients that moved out of shelter from January to December 2024 maintained stable housing.

In March 2025, Brandy Rickaby became the Executive Director of New Generation. Brandy, herself once a resident and client of New Generation, joined the staff in 2019. Before becoming the Executive Director, Brandy was the Family Services Manager for New Generation. In that role she oversaw the program's case management, life-skills coaching, parenting counseling, and other supportive services that are key to nurturing family development, financial literacy, and building long-term stability.

FY24 funded organizations must submit a brief summary of how those funds were used to support Exeter residents

In 2024, approximately 19% of the families New Generation served, for all program components, were from Exeter, and 100% of the women living at New Generation applied for housing in Exeter.

It is estimated that a week of shelter, food, and transportation, including support and case management provided to a family of two (mother and child) costs New Generation approximately \$2,567, a cost that the town of Exeter does not have to fund. The Exeter residents whom New Generation have assisted most recently have stayed an average of three to six months, resulting in significant relief for the Town of Exeter's welfare expenditures.

New Generation also collaborates with many local agencies. Those most frequently engaged with are Seacoast Mental Health Center, Exeter Housing Authority, Gather, Hope on Haven Hill, Ritchie McFarland Children's Center, and the St. Vincent de Paul Society.

This responds to your August 26, 2024, request for information regarding the status of your group tax exemption.

Our records indicate that you were issued a determination letter in March 1946, that you are currently exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, and are not a private foundation within the meaning of section 509(a) of the Code because you are described in sections 509(a)(1) and 170(b)(1)(A)(i).

With your request, you provided a copy of the Official Catholic Directory for 2024, which includes the names and addresses of the agencies and instrumentalities and the educational, charitable, and religious institutions operated by the Roman Catholic Church in the United States, its territories, and possessions that are subordinate organizations under your group tax exemption. Your request indicated that each subordinate organization is a non-profit organization, that no part of the net earnings thereof inures to the benefit of any individual, and that no substantial part of their activities is for promotion of legislation. You have further represented that none of your subordinate organizations is a private foundation under section 509(a), although all subordinates do not all share the same sub-classification under section 509(a). Based on your representations, the subordinate organizations in the Official Catholic Directory for 2024 are recognized as exempt under section 501(c)(3) of the Code under GEN 0928.

Donors may deduct contributions to you and your subordinate organizations as provided in section 170 of the Code. Bequests, legacies, devises, transfers, or gifts to them or for their use are deductible for federal estate and gifts tax purposes if they meet the applicable provisions of section 2055, 2106, and 2522 of the Code.

Subordinate organizations under a group exemption do not receive individual exemption letters. Subordinate organizations are not listed in Tax Exempt Organization Search (Pub 78 data), and many are not listed in the Exempt Organizations Business Master

File extract, or EO BMF. Donors may verify that a subordinate organization is included in your group exemption by consulting the *Official Catholic Directory*, the official subordinate listing approved by you, or by contacting you directly. IRS does not verify the inclusion of subordinate organizations under your group exemption. See IRS Publication 4573, *Group Exemption*, for additional information about group exemptions.


