- When you cross off three in a row (in any direction), bring your bingo sheet to the circulation desk for an **entry to a special book giveaway!**
- Teens who cross off EVERY box in the bingo challenge will be invited to an end-of-summer **pizza party** to celebrate your reading!
- **Note**: one book CAN count for multiple categories. For example, if you read "Anger is a Gift" you could cross off the boxes for "Black character" and "LGBTQ character."
- **Note**: only books that you read DURING summer reading count towards the challenge.
