Position Title: Summer Camp Counselor

Works under the supervision of the Head Counselors to plan and execute all camp activities for their assigned age group.

Position Responsibilities:

- All jobs are considered seasonal and one-year positions.
- Assist your supervisor in organizing, promoting, leading, teaching and conducting camp activities.
- Enforcing the rules and regulations established by the EPRD to ensure the safety and welfare of participants
- Inspect facilities and equipment daily for hazards and unsafe conditions. Report problems to your supervisor.
- Report on activities, participants, plans, programs, and needs.
- Maintain confidentiality
- Attend staff meetings as required.
- Become acquainted with information and resources available to improve the program.
- Participate in all activities of the children under your care. This means participation in water activities, games, crafts and other activities.
- Perform set up, take down, and cleanup of all activities. This may involve cleaning bathrooms, picking up trash, and keeping supplies in an orderly fashion.
- Perform other related duties as required
- Must be willing to obtain Red Cross CPR/1st Aid/AED certification, if not already certified.
- Required to wear a uniform.

Time Commitment:

40 hours per week, from June through August. Monday-Friday.

Pay: \$15.00 - \$17.50 hourly, depending on qualifications.

Qualifications:

- Excellent customer service skills.
- Ability to remain calm and make appropriate decisions.
- Good cross-cultural communication skills and the ability to work with a diverse population.
- Ability to communicate effectively, both written and verbal.
- Ability to effectively communicate in both one on one and group settings.
- Must be able to work entire season and attend trainings (June through August).
- Must be willing to obtain Red Cross CPR/1st Aid/AED certification, if not already certified.

- Ability to frequently stand.
- Regularly lift, carry, push, pull, or otherwise move objects weighing up to 25 lbs.
