Position Title: Summer Camp Counselor in Training

Works with counselors and supervisors to plan and execute all camp activities for assigned age group in a safe manner.

Position Responsibilities:

- All jobs are considered seasonal and one-year positions.
- Assist in organizing, promoting, leading, teaching, and conducting camp activities.
- Assist in enforcing the rules and regulations established by the SAC to ensure the safety and welfare of participants.
- Inspect facilities and equipment for hazards and unsafe conditions daily. Report problems to the Camp Counselors.
- Make recommendations to the Supervisor of your Group of activities and programs that would work in the program
- Participate in all activities as a supervisor of the children under your care
- Perform set-up, take down and clean up for all activities. This may involve cleaning bathrooms, picking up trash, and keeping the supplies stored in an orderly fashion.
- Maintain confidentiality.
- Attend weekly staff meetings as needed.
- Perform other duties as required
- Must be willing to obtain Red Cross CPR/1st Aid/AED certification, if not already certified.
- Required to wear uniform.

40 hours per week, from June through August. Monday-Friday.
