EVENT: Revisit one of the world's most beloved musicals. FIDDLER ON THE ROOF follows Tevye, a poor milkman who is searching for husbands for his daughters to uphold his family's religious and cultural traditions in their small pre-revolutionary Russian village. Featuring the classic Tony® and Oscar®-winning score including "Tradition," "If I Were a Rich Man," "Sunrise, Sunset" and "Matchmaker, Matchmaker" FIDDLER ON THE ROOF is a generational musical tradition for the whole family! **Lunch is included in your registration fee.** Before settling in to our seats at the theatre, we'll stop for lunch at The Cheesecake Factory.

<u>DATE</u>: The date selected is Wednesday, June 5, 2024. We will depart the Exeter Recreation Center parking lot at 10:30am and will be returning to Exeter at approximately 5:45pm.

FEE: The fee is **\$85.00** (residents) or **\$105.00** (non-residents) per person that includes transportation in the recreation department van, admission to Fiddler on the Roof and lunch at The Cheesecake Factory.

<u>DEADLINE</u>: The deadline to register is **Friday**, **May 3**, **2024** or once the van is sold out. **Note: We need a minimum of 8 people registered. Max of 12 people.**

<u>REFUNDS</u>: No refunds after tickets/reservations have been purchased unless we can find a replacement for your spot in the program.*

*Medical Injury/Illness Policy: If there is a medically documented injury/illness we will prorate a refund after we receive written medical varication from your physician which must be received prior to the trip.

<u>Accessibility Guidelines:</u> The EPRD van is not wheelchair accessible. While we are able to accommodate a range of mobility levels, all participants must be able to step up into the van and step out of the van on their own without assistance. All trips will be rated for accessibility. Please refer to the top of the flyer for the accessibility rating to determine if this trip matches your level of comfort with walking, stairs, and uneven ground.
