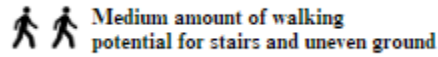




Freeport Maine Holiday Shopping Trip Friday, December 6, 2024



EVENT: Join Exeter Parks & Rec for a holiday shopping trip to the Freeport, Maine Outlets. Participants will be driven in the Recreation Department van and will get to enjoy holiday shopping at Freeport's numerous outlets and stores including L.L. Bean, Patagonia, Talbots, J.Crew, Gap, Nike, Carter's, The Vermont Flannel Store, local artisanal sores and more! We will arrive in Freeport around 10:30am and participants will have 4 hours to shop and dine where they choose. Lunch is on your own. We will depart Freeport at 2:30pm and arrive back in Exeter around 4:00pm.

DATE: The date selected is Friday, December 6, 2024. We will depart the Exeter Recreation Center parking lot at 9:00am and will be returning to Exeter approximately 4:00pm.

FEE: The fee is **\$5.00 for residents and \$10.00 for non-residents**, which includes transportation to and from Freeport, Maine in the Recreation Department Van. Please note: **Lunch is NOT included on this trip**, but there are ample dining options for lunch on your own.

DEADLINE: The deadline to register is Friday, November 29, or once the van is sold out.

Note: We need a minimum of 8 people registered. Max of 12 people.

REFUNDS: No refunds after the registration deadline unless we can find a replacement for your spot in the program. *

*Medical Injury/Illness Policy: If there is a medically documented injury/illness we will prorate a refund after we receive written medical varication from your physician which must be received prior to the trip.

Accessibility Guidelines: The EPRD van is not wheelchair accessible. While we are able to accommodate a range of mobility levels, all participants must be able to step up into the van and step out of the van on their own without assistance. All trips will be rated for accessibility. Please refer to the top of the flyer for the accessibility rating to determine if this trip matches your level of comfort with walking, stairs, and uneven ground.
