

## **Kennebunkport Day Trip**

Kennebunkport, ME Trolley Tour, Lunch, and Shopping Wednesday, July 24, 2024

**EVENT:** Join EPRD for a day trip to Kennebunkport, Maine. We will start with a Trolley Tour of historic Kennebunkport visiting various sights including, President Bush's Estate, the Franciscan Monastery, the Beaches, Spouting Rock, Blowing Cave and more. The narrated tour will last one hour and will include information on Kennebunkport's 300-year history, famous sights and more. Following our Trolley Tour, we will have lunch in downtown Kennebunkport at The Boathouse Restaurant. After lunch, participants will have time to shop, explore and enjoy downtown Kennebunkport.

**DATE:** The date selected is Wednesday, July 24, 2024. We will depart the Exeter Recreation Center parking lot at 9:00am and will be returning to Exeter at approximately 4:00pm

**FEE:** The fee is \$70.00 for residents and \$87.00 for non-residents, which includes a narrated trolley tour, lunch, and transportation in the Recreation Department's van.

**DEADLINE:** The deadline to register is Friday, July 12, 2024, or once the van is sold out.

Note: We need a minimum of 8 people registered for this trip. Maximum is 12.

**REFUNDS:** No refunds after reservations have been made unless we can find a replacement for your spot in the program.\*

\*Medical Injury/Illness Policy: If there is a medically documented injury/illness we will prorate a refund after we receive written medical varication from your physician which must be received prior to the trip.

**Accessibility Guidelines**: The EPRD van is not wheelchair accessible. While we are able to accommodate a range of mobility levels, all participants must be able to step up into the van and step out of the van on their own without assistance. All trips will be rated for accessibility. Please refer to the top of the flyer for the accessibility rating to determine if this trip matches your level of comfort with walking, stairs, and uneven ground.
