EVENT: Join EPRD for a sail on the top-rated replica of the 1812 privateer Fame, one of Salem's premier activities. You can be as hands-on as you wish — help raise the sails or just enjoy your time on the water. This tour combines the beautiful sights of a sailing trip in Salem, the fun of helping the crew with the sails, and the educational experience of learning about the history of the vessel and the War of 1812. The crew is knowledgeable and friendly, and they share interesting facts with a bit of humor. Please note sensible shoes, sunscreen, hats, and sunglasses are always a good idea. It's cooler on the water, so you may want to bring a jacket or sweatshirt. There is a tidal ramp to get up to the boat as well as 5 steps up and 3 steps down. There is a railing to hold onto as well as staff that will be there to assist with boarding the ship. Before we set sail, we will have lunch at Sea Level Oyster Bar.

DATE: The date selected is Wednesday, June 26, 2024. We will depart the Exeter Recreation Center parking lot at 10:00am and will be returning to Exeter at approximately 4:00pm

FEE: The fee is **\$66.00 for residents and \$83.00 for non-residents**, which includes an interactive sailing tour, lunch, and transportation in the Recreation Department's van.

DEADLINE: The deadline to register is Friday, June 7, 2024, or once the van is sold out.

Note: We need a minimum of 8 people registered for this trip. Maximum is 12.

REFUNDS: No refunds after reservations have been made unless we can find a replacement for your spot in the program.*

*Medical Injury/Illness Policy: If there is a medically documented injury/illness we will prorate a refund after we receive written medical varication from your physician which must be received prior to the trip.

Accessibility Guidelines: The EPRD van is not wheelchair accessible. While we are able to accommodate a range of mobility levels, all participants must be able to step up into the van and step out of the van on their own without assistance. All trips will be rated for accessibility. Please refer to the top of the flyer for the accessibility rating to determine if this trip matches your level of comfort with walking, stairs, and uneven ground.
