**EVENT:** The Exeter Parks & Recreation Department invites you to join us on our trip to Boston, MA. Once in Boston, we will board one of the world famous amphibious vehicles to explore the city by land and by sea. **DATE:** The date selected is Wednesday, June 12<sup>th</sup>, 2024. We will depart the Exeter Recreation Center parking lot at 8:30am and will be returning to Exeter approximately 4:30pm.

<u>FEE:</u> The Fee is **\$76.00 Resident**, **\$95 nonresident price** that includes transportation in our recreation van, Boston Duck Tour admission ticket, and lunch at S&S restaurant! S&S offers everything from traditional deli, to innovative entrees, to award winning desserts.

DEADLINE: The deadline to register Monday, June 10<sup>th</sup>, or once the van is sold out. **Note: We need a minimum of 8 people registered. Max of 12 people.** 

**<u>REFUNDS</u>**: No refunds after tickets/reservations have been purchased unless we can find a replacement for your spot in the program.\*

\*Medical Injury/Illness Policy: If there is a medically documented injury/illness we will prorate a refund after we receive written medical verification from your physician which must be received prior to the trip.

**<u>GUIDELINES</u>**: Registrants must sit in the same seat(s) on the return trip as they sat in on the first part of the trip. If you have a need requiring you to sit in a particular area, please let the Recreation Office know when you register for the trip. The staff will relay to the trip escort that he/she needs to be sure you get the necessary seat. **Parents** are expected to have complete control of their children at all times throughout the trip.

Exeter Parks & Recreation Department sponsored trips are designed to provide members of the Exeter Community - families, friends, and individuals alike - with safe, relaxing and enjoyable sports and entertainment experiences. To ensure these goals, the Exeter Parks and Recreation Department has established a policy of prohibiting the possession and use of alcohol and other drugs while on board.
