


NH Highland Games & Festival

Lincoln, NH Saturday, September 21, 2024





EVENT: The NH Highland Games & Festival is one of the largest and most diverse Highland Games held in North America. This celebration of Scottish Heritage will be held on September 21, 2024, at Loon Mountain Resort in the White Mountains of New Hampshire at the beginning of fall foliage season in New England. There's something for everyone from Scottish music, dance, food, and fun to heavy athletics, sheep dog trials, and crowd-favorite, massed bands. Try-It classes all day long in street curling, stone lifting, and more. The event runs from 9am to 5pm. We will be partnering with Hampton Parks & Rec and taking a 55 Passenger Coach Bus!

<u>DATE:</u> The date selected is Saturday, September 21, 2024. We will depart from Hampton Park & Ride, located on Timber Swamp Road in Hampton at 7:00am and will be returning to Hampton at approximately 7:00pm

<u>FEE:</u> The fee is \$100.00 for residents and \$125.00 for non-residents, which includes entrance to the event and transportation in a 55-passenger coach bus. Lunch is not included. The following Add-Ons are available: *Whiskey & Spirits Tasting Tent*: \$32 - 11am or 2pm.

<u>**DEADLINE:**</u> The deadline to register is Friday, September 13, 2024, or once the bus is sold out. **Note: We have a Maximum of 27 spots available.**

REFUNDS: No refunds after tickets/reservations have been purchased unless we can find a replacement for your spot in the program. *

*Medical Injury/Illness Policy: If there is a medically documented injury/illness we will prorate a refund after we receive written medical varication from your physician which must be received prior to the trip.

<u>Accessibility Guidelines:</u> The coach bus is not wheelchair accessible. While we can accommodate a range of mobility levels, all participants must be able to step up onto the bus and step out of the bus on their own without assistance. All trips will be rated for accessibility. Please refer to the top of the flyer for the accessibility rating to determine if this trip matches your level of comfort with walking, stairs, and uneven ground.

Exeter Parks & Recreation Department sponsored trips are designed to provide members of the Exeter Community - families, friends, and individuals alike - with safe, relaxing and enjoyable sports and entertainment experiences.
