


Pickity Place

EVENT: Since 1786, Pickity Place's quaint little red cottage has graced the hills of southern New Hampshire, seemingly untouched by time. Join us as we travel to Mason, NH for a 5-course meal featuring herbs, vegetables, and spices grown locally in the fertile NH soil. We'll have a chance to visit the gift shop and garden/greenhouses located on site. This enchanting cottage was chosen by Elizabeth Orton Jones as the model for her illusions in Little Red Riding Hood. Today it is a mecca for gardeners, foodies, and anyone looking for inspiration and relaxation. **Lunch is at 11:30am.**

<u>DATE:</u> The date selected is Wednesday, April 10, 2024. We will depart the Exeter Recreation Center parking lot at 9:15am and will be returning to Exeter between 2:30pm – 3:00pm.

<u>FEE:</u> The Fee is \$52.00 for residents and \$65.00 for non-residents, which includes admission to Pickity Place (5-course lunch gratuity included) and transportation in the Recreation Department's van

<u>DEADLINE:</u> The deadline to register is Friday, April 5, 2024, or once the van is sold out.

Note: We need a minimum of 8 people registered for this trip. Maximum is 12.

<u>GUIDELINES</u>: Registrants must sit in the same seat(s) on the return trip as they sat in on the first part of the trip. **If** you have a need requiring you to sit in a particular area, please let the Recreation Office know when you register for the trip. The staff will relay to the trip escort that he/she needs to be sure you get the necessary seat. **Parents** are expected to have complete control of their children at all times throughout the trip.
