


BOSTON RED SOX vs. KANSAS CITY ROYALS FRIDAY, JULY 12, 2024





<u>EVENT</u>: Join the Exeter Parks & Recreation Department as we head to historic Fenway Park to see the Boston Red Sox host the Kansas City Royals! Cheer on your Boston Red Sox, sing Sweet Caroline and enjoy the action at America's most beloved ballpark. **Bags larger than 12x12x6 will not be permitted at Fenway, with the exception of medical items and diaper bags. Prohibited items include (not limited to): backpacks, duffle bags, and multi-compartment bags (regardless of size).**

<u>DATES & TIMES</u>: The date selected is Friday, July 12, 2024. The van will depart from the Exeter Parks & Recreation parking lot at 32 Court St, Exeter at **4:00pm.** We'll arrive at the Stadium approximately 1.5 hours prior to the game, enough time to see warm ups, have something to eat or visit local business attractions. Seating reserved in right field Grandstand Section 30 rows 12, 13 and 14. Return time to Exeter is approximately 11:30PM (time subject to change due to game outcome).

<u>FEE:</u> The fee is \$85.00 for residents and non-residents, which includes ticket and transportation in the Recreation Department Van.

<u>REGISTRATION:</u> Payment is due upon registration. Cost includes game seats and transportation. Registration may be made through the Exeter Recreation Department Office via cash, check, Visa, MasterCard, Discover, Apple or Google Pay. Checks made payable to: E.P.R.D. **SORRY, NO REFUNDS UNLESS THE TRIP IS CANCELLED OR WE CAN FILL YOUR SPOT. A REFUND IS NOT PROCESSED IN THE EVENT OF A RESCHEDULED GAME. SEE INCLEMENT WEATHER GUIDELINES. THERE WILL BE A \$20 FEE CHARGED FOR EACH BANK RETURNED CHECK.**

<u>**DEADLINE:**</u> Space is limited, registration deadline is **Friday**, **July 5**, **2024** or once the trip is filled. We need a **Minimum of 8 people registered. Max of 13 people.**

<u>GUIDELINES</u>: Registrants must sit in the same seat(s) on the return trip as they sat in on the first part of the trip. **If** you have a need requiring you to sit in a particular area, please let the Recreation Office know when you register for the trip. The staff will relay to the trip escort that he/she needs to be sure you get the necessary seat. **Parents** are expected to have complete control of their children at all times throughout the trip.

Exeter Parks & Recreation Department sponsored trips are designed to provide members of the Exeter Community - families, friends, and individuals alike - with safe, relaxing and enjoyable sports and entertainment experiences. To ensure these goals, the Exeter Parks and Recreation Department has established a policy of prohibiting the possession and use of alcohol and other drugs while on board.
