EVENT: The Exeter Parks and Recreation Department is partnering again with the Exeter Conservation Commission to offer free, easy to moderate, family-friendly guided hiking expeditions. We have scheduled four hikes throughout Exeter to showcase our community's great natural resources! Please view the dates below and parking directions for each hike. **Required, registration with Exeter Parks & Recreation for each hike is mandatory.** Optional, snowshoes are available for rent (\$5/person) in the event we have a snowy hike.

DATES & TIMES:

- 1. February 27, 3:00 4:30pm: Oaklands Town Forest
 - a. Parking Directions: Epping Rd over Rt. 101, take 1st right onto Watson Rd. Go 1.25 miles, park in the lot at the top of the hill under the power lines.
- 2. March 27, 3:00 4:30pm: Gilman to PEA Trails
 - a. Parking Directions: Park at Gilman Park located off of Bell Ave.
- 3. April 24, 3:00 4:30pm: Cubie Road Trails
 - a. Parking Directions: Epping Rd to Old Town Farm Rd. Follow to end. Small lot at the junction of Old Town Farm Rd and Beech Hill Rd.
- 4. May 22, 3:00 4:30pm: Henderson Swasey
 - a. Parking Directions: From Main St, take Epping Rd and turn right after the school buses onto Industrial Dr. Go 1/3 of a mile and turn right onto Commerce Way. Park along the traffic circle at the end.

REGISTRATION: FREE PROGRAM! Registration is open to residents and nonresidents on a first-come, first-served basis. Participants under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian. Please register for this FREE program online, by phone or in person at the Parks & Recreation office, located at 32 Court St. Exeter, NH. 25 maximum number of participants per hike.
