## The Drawing Workshop

May 8 – June 26



**PROGRAM:** This course is designed for those with some drawing experience or students that completed the Drawing Level 1 class. This workshop builds upon your fundamental skills with deeper dives into technique, composition, and a broader range of media. Development of artistic personality and perception will also be worked on as part of the course. Homework is encouraged. The emphasis will be on fun in a supportive, informal group setting.

This course includes:

- Further development of skills in rendering three-dimensional forms in realistic space.
- Using line and value to render forms based on observation of the visual world. Drawing from reality (when the weather is favorable) or pictures will be incorporated.
- Experience in handling varied drawing media including graphite, charcoal, and ink pen on white and toned papers.
- Development of successful compositions. Understanding and using pictorial space.
- Exposure to relevant historical art precedents and contemporary artists.
- Development of personal imagery and your own artistic perception and style.

**SUPPLIES:** See reverse page for needed supplies. Participants purchase their own supplies (approximately \$35 for all supplies).

**REGISTRATION:** Registration is open to all aged 18 and over on a first-come, first-served basis. Registrations are accepted at the Exeter Recreation Office during our business hours, online, mail or by phone. Payment must be made at the time of registration. Late registrations are on a first-come, first-bases pending availability. Class size minimum is 4 students, maximum 8 students.

Sorry, no refunds unless the program is cancelled or a doctor's note saying you cannot participate in the program. There is a \$20 fee for each returned check.

## Materials and Supplies for Drawing Classes

Supplies for DRAWING LEVEL 1 CLASSES are simple and relatively inexpensive. You should have:

**A DRAWING PAD AT LEAST 9”X12”** (Larger is fine.) High-end drawing paper is not necessary. We’ll be doing lots of sketching and quick practice drawings so almost any drawing pad will do fine to begin.

**GRAPHITE DRAWING PENCILS.** Several soft lead pencils — grade 6B or 7B. You may want to get a half-dozen or so. It is NOT necessary to purchase a pencil kit of varied hardnesses or charcoal. Prismacolor “Ebony” pencils highly recommended.

**A DRAWING BOARD** large enough to support individual paper sheets is required.

**PENCIL SHARPENER.** A simple grade-school type personal sharpener is fine.

**A “PLASTIC” ERASER** is also highly recommended although any artist-quality eraser will suffice. Plastic erasers don’t shed “crumbs” and are less abrasive than other typical erasers. Staedtler Mars Plastic Eraser is recommended. Or, the classic pink rubber slab eraser is acceptable too.

**ARTIST DRAFTING TAPE** to hold the sheets in place on your drawing board. Painters tape is acceptable and is likely cheaper if purchased at a discount house like Odd Lots. Half-inch width minimum.

Supplies for DRAWING LEVEL 2 CLASSES:

All supplies as for Drawing Level 1 plus:

**General's Charcoal Pencil Kit (or equivalent.)** Includes three charcoal pencils (2B, 4B, 6B). One Charcoal White pencil. One kneaded eraser.

**Faber-Castell PITT Artist Black Pen Set, four-piece, (or equivalent.)** Nibs include fine, superfine, medium, brush.

**Strathmore 400 Series Recycled Toned Tan Sketch Paper Pad (or equivalent.)**  
9” x 12” minimum size.

**Strathmore® 400 Series Mixed Media Paper Pad.** 9” x 12” minimum size.
