## **Beginner Art Relaxation Class**

**PROGRAM**: One 2-hour class will give you an overview to be able to create beautiful and intriguing pieces of art that are frameable and interesting to view. She is able to demystify art supplies from gum erasers to techniques to color and mostly to let go and take chances.
