The Town received the following two questions on May 31, 2017 regarding the Transportation Alternatives Program Sidewalk project. Each question is listed below followed by the Town's answers in italics.

- **Q.** As discussed at the meeting, coordination with the State Historic Preservation Office will be required per LPA rules. However, I was wondering if any special coordination or meetings with the Historic District Commission will be required (particularly for Spring Street)?
- **A.** The Spring Street portion of the project is in the Historic District but to the extent local review is pursued; Town staff will coordinate any local historic review and will not expect the engineer to attend any of these meetings.
- **Q.** Our Marketing Department had a question about the page count. We see that the max 16 page count includes the cover letter, resumes, and schedule. However, they were wondering if the 16 pages includes the front & back cover and any tabs/section dividers (likely not needed)? My assumption was these would not be counted but I figured its best to check.
- **A.** Front and back covers and any tabs/section dividers will NOT be counted toward the 16 page response limit.
