WATER SERVICE INTERRUPTION

This notice is being given to you because there will be a temporary interruption in the water service to your building. This is part of the Lincoln St Utility Improvement Project.

The water main will be shut down at 10 am on Tuesday, December 1, 2015.

The following properties will be affected for approximately 1 hour:

Lincoln Street: 40 through 97 (from Garfield St to Main St), including the north half of the Lincoln St School

Tremont Street: Entire street

Daniel Street: Entire street

The following properties will be affected until approximately 3 pm:

Front Street: 105

Garfield Court: Entire street

Garfield Street: 2, 7-9, 10, 14, 15

Lincoln Street: 32-34, 36-38

Union Street: Entire street

Provisions should be made for longer disruption should problems develop. It is recommended that you have an adequate supply for these nights. Precautions may include filling pitchers or plastic jugs for drinking water, filling sink and bathtubs for domestic use or purchasing bottled water. When water service resumes, we recommend that you run the water for a few minutes to remove any sediment that may have been dislodged from the pipes.

We apologize for any inconveniences and thank you for your cooperation.

Property Owners: Please make sure that all of your tenants are aware of the water service interruption.
