Separate sealed BIDS for the construction of the Lary Lane Groundwater Treatment Plant, Contract 2014-1 will be received at the Town of Exeter, Town Hall, Town Manager's Office, 10 Front Street, Exeter, New Hampshire, 03833, until 3:00 P.M. local time on Monday March 10, 2014. BIDS will then be publicly opened and read aloud during the Board of Selectman's meeting at 7:00 pm that evening.

The scope of work for the Base Bid includes construction of the new Treatment Plant building, all process equipment and piping, all electrical, plumbing, HVAC, and SCADA, a backwash lagoon, access road, and site work. The work also includes renovation of two existing pump stations, including new pumps and piping, demolition of existing equipment, installation of new equipment and reactivation of a groundwater supply well.

The scope of work for Bid Alternate A includes installation of new precast pump station, site work, pump, piping, instrumentation, and reactivation of a groundwater supply well as shown on the plans.

1. Completion time for the project will be calculated as calendar days from the date specified in the "Notice to Proceed" as follows:

440 calendar days for substantial completion.

470 calendar days for final completion.

The Bidder further agrees to pay as liquidated damages the sum identified for each milestone, as noted below, for each consecutive calendar day that the work has not been completed.

Milestone No. 1

Milestone Date: Substantial Completion (440 Days)

Liquidated Damages: \$2,000

Milestone No. 2

Milestone Date: Final Completion (470 Days)

Liquidated Damages: \$10,000

2. Each General Bid shall be accompanied by a Bid Security in the amount of 5% of the Total Bid Price.

3. The successful Bidder must furnish 100% Performance and Payment Bonds and will be required to execute the Contract Agreement within 10 days following notification of the acceptance of his Bid.

4. Any contract or contracts awarded under this Advertisement for Bids are expected to be funded in whole or in part by:

a loan from the NH State Drinking Water Revolving Loan Fund (DWSRF)

5. The successful Bidder on this work is required to comply with the President's Executive Order No. 11246 entitled "Equal Employment Opportunity" as amended by Executive Order 11375, and amendments or supplements thereto, and as supplemented in Department of Labor Regulations (41 CFR Part 80). The requirements for bidders and contractors

6. Utilization of Minority and Women's Business Enterprises (MBEs and WBEs)

The successful Bidder on this work must demonstrate compliance with the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's MBE/WBE policy in order to be deemed a responsible bidder. The requirements for bidders and contractors covered by this policy are explained in the Information for Bidders.

7. The successful Bidder on this work is subject to U.S. Department of Labor's Davis Bacon wage provisions.

8. No Bidder may withdraw a Bid within 60 days after the actual date of opening thereof.
