

ADDENDUM 1

The following information is forwarded to all qualified bidders for the above project for bids due June 1, 2026 at 3:00 PM. This addendum shall be signed by all BIDDERS and included with the Bid Form.

Following are questions received from prospective bidders at the May 19 pre-bid meeting with associated answers. Representatives from W.P. Excavation and MBCS construction were in attendance.

Q1: *Has the town considered adding a yard hydrant within the roundabout to irrigate the landscaping?*

A: The town may consider this as a change order. The Town is not encouraging a high degree of landscaping in the center of the roundabout due mostly to maintenance concerns.

Q2: *There does not seem to be a reinforcing detail for the concrete truck apron.*

A: The apron should be reinforced. A detail is attached to this addendum.

Q3: *As there any nearby town land for staging?*

A: The town has some space on Kingston Road opposite Brickyard Pond and some further out on the Simpson property. These are not exactly nearby.

Q4: *Will town police be used on this project?*

A: Police will be needed in addition to flaggers during peak traffic hours. The contract includes a dollar allowance for police.

Q5: *Can the intersection be shut down at night for paving?*

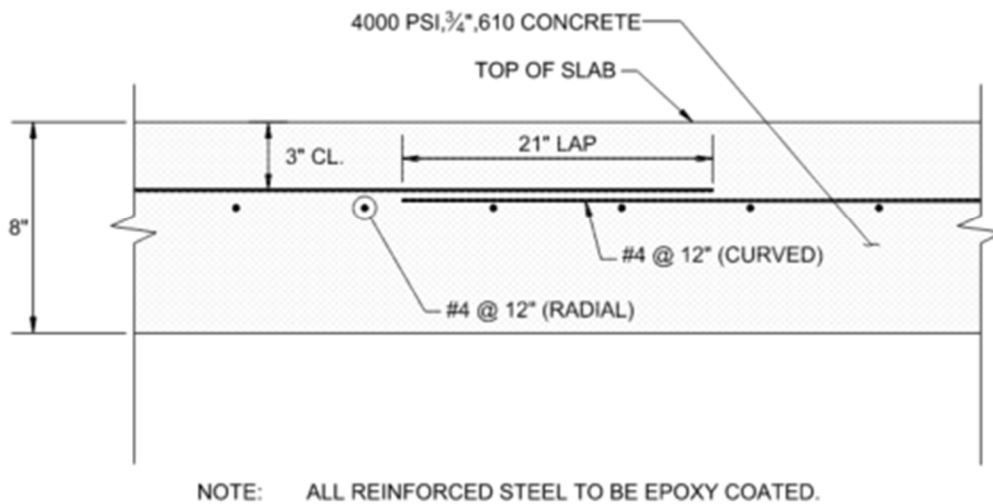
A: The town will consider this. The Contractor should provide a detour plan for consideration.

Additional Discussion Points:

Night Work:

The Prosecution of Work includes language noting that night work will be considered with advance notice. The Town recognizes the advantages due to the high peak hour traffic on Front Street but night work should be minimized due to the local residents.
