- Last July we learned that the town would need an additional \$3.5 million dollars to complete the siphon project. We attended the hearing and voted to solve a difficult problem.
- We accepted this as taxpayers and community members
- Now we have been given a gift to replace an eyesore of over 30 years with a small pocket park
- After all those years excitement grew as did volunteers eager to help
- Process does have its place, but so does opportunity
