


Did you know that about 7% of our solid waste is textiles? That's an estimated 28 million pounds each year!

Since April 2017, we've collected and converted **76 million pounds** of direct-from-consumer clothes into:


- 120 full-time living-wage jobs
- \$3 million in waste disposal fees avoided
- Clothing reuse for **1.5 million** people





How does **HELPSY** operate?


- With a fleet of 27 trucks and a team of 45 friendly drivers
- We work out of 3 warehouses in NY, NJ, MA and 5 depots in NJ, MD, SC
- We have done hundreds of successful clothing drives & service **200 bin** locations from our Medford warehouse
- We have around the clock customer service





Who is **HELPSY**?

- We are the largest clothing collection company on the East Coast
- In 2021, we're diverting over **30** million pounds of textiles
- We have a team of over **120** employees paid full-time living wages, an 140% increase since COVID
- We are the **only B Corp** in the clothing collection industry


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HELPSY Location Map

Clothing Drives

- HELPSY's municipal clothing drives average around **6,000 lbs**
- HELPSY organizes, then picks up all the discarded textiles.
- HELPSY pays the host a royalty per pound of collected textiles.



HELPSY's Home Pickups: How Does It Work?

- Pickup dates are based on zip codes and customized avoid conflicts with existing trash routes.
- Residents get confirmation when they schedule AND alerts along the way and on the day of when our driver is close.
