Mr. Short made a motion and seconded by Mr. Damsell to move forward with the pruning to be done by the same person as last year. The specifics of the pruning has been gone over with the contractor for this year and the price will be \$2,750.00 which is less than last year.

Mr. Short and Mr. Damsell agreed to work on possible donations that the Trustees have been approached on being given.

The opening of the bids for the maintenance for the 2021 season will be held on 11/30/2020 in the Nowak room at the Town offices at 3:30pm.

Mr. Staples informed the Trustees that he had received a call that the sewer lines in the Parkway were going to be cleaned the week of 11/2/2020 and there may be some odor when this is being done.

It was discussed to call the parade committee and offer the Parkway for the reverse parade that was being planned for in December.

A motion was made by Mr. Damsell and seconded by Mr. Short to adjourn at 4:50pm. Motion passed unanimously.
