22 23 24 25		Chair Staples reported on events scheduled for the months of June and July at the Parkway The Farmer's Market is ongoing through the month of June and July. TEAMS will be hosting concerts in the Park in July and the Recreation Dept. will be hosting movies in the Park in July.

31 32 33		Mr. Short reported the fence repair was made and he is awaiting the invoice. The granite posts were ordered but the holes were not drilled correctly which has resulted in the posts being replaced and a four-week delay. Chair Staples will follow-up.
34		Mr. Short asked if the broken granite that was left at the site could be pulled out of there.
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# • Planting along fence behind Harris Center

- 37 Chair Staples reviewed the planting plan behind the Harris Center which had included Elms,
- White Pine, Gray Dogwood, Viburnum and Coral Berry. There was no sidewalk there in
- 39 1931.
- Mr. Short recommended a site walk be scheduled and asked if rather than grinding the
- stumps the root system could be broken along the sidewalk so as not to disturb the sidewalk
- and the stumps popped with a backhoe. Mr. Short noted that replanting the area would be
- more successful if they were not planting on stump ground debris.

# 44 • Turf Aeration

- Chair Staples recommended areas for aeration. He noted the tree companies did some air
- spading recently and the entire Parkway was done four years ago by Hillside. He
- 47 recommended having aeration done from Water Street to the Pavilion on the river side and
- across from the Pavilion, in the fall and possibly spring.
- 49 Mr. Short recommended getting costs and availability for the fall, for the next meeting.

## Sewer Project

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Chair Staples reported that he spoke to Matt Berube in the last two weeks and he advised the sewer project has been delayed to late summer/early fall. Chair Staples recommended keeping the mowing company up to date with any road closures.

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## Other Business

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Mr. Thompson thanked the DPW for putting in the additional carry in/carry out and speed bump signs.

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Mr. Short reported the top of the Cherry Tree planted for Highland Hardwoods has died and Joe has offered to replace it and take care of watering. Chair Staples noted the memorial tree was planted for Highland Hardwoods and he will reach out to Heather.

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### Public Comment

Select Board Chair Papakonstantis noted that at their May 31<sup>st</sup> meeting the Select Board expressed its thanks to Mark Damsell, the tree companies and local eateries for their help on the day of the tree work. He noted the Parkway is still a work in progress with the Attorney General and he is meeting with the Town Manager tomorrow and will have an update in time for the next Select Board meeting. He will express the request for additional signage near the Pavilion.
