## 1. Call Meeting to Order:

Chair Staples called the meeting to order at 5:00 PM and introduced the members who were Present
2. Introductions:

Present were: Chair Dwane Staples, and Vice-Chair Darius Thompson

## 3. Public Comment

Chair Staples asked if there were any comments from the public at 5:00 PM and there were none.

## 4. Approval of Meeting Minutes

January 18, 2023
Chair Staples motioned to approve the January 18, 2023 meeting minutes. Mr. Thompson seconded the motion. A vote was taken, all were in favor, the motion passed 2-0-0.

## 5. Planting along fence behind Harris Center

Chair Staples noted they can't get in with the construction going on for the sewer placement. There is an original planting list which can be reviewed at the April site walk as to what materials to use substituting materials that are now considered invasive for native but noninvasive species.

## 6. Tree and Shrub Pruning

Chair Staples noted the tree pruning will be delayed due to the sewer project but will discuss shrub planting further at the site walk. Some shrubs should be removed. Chair Staples met with the contractor to target replacing invasives with flowering native plants which would attract wildlife and birds.
7. Sewer Project

Chair Staples reported he attended the construction meeting this morning and they completed the pilot hole. The project was delayed due to ledge and they have no definite end time but will have a better idea next week.

Mr. Thompson asked if Exeter TV was documenting the project and how its done. Chair Staples noted someone was filming the bore as it come out on the other side of the river.

## 8. Fund Balances

Chair Staples reviewed the fund balances and copied Mr. Thompson and Mr. Short (by email). The maintenance fund was over and $\$ 15,500$ will be transferred to be returned to the Town. The Town will fund Swasey with $\$ 3,600$ via Warrant Article this year which will go back to maintenance.

Chair Staples indicated they were getting permitting fees and quarterly payments from the Trust in Ohio.

Mr. Thompson raised concerns with the overage on the budget for electrical which is \$950 with costs over $\$ 1,500$ and the pavilion, which is owned by the Town, being used to generate electricity to event applicants. He questioned whether this could be offset somehow. Chair Staples will ask Select Board Representative Papakonstantis at the March meeting.

## 9. Other Business

Chair Staples thanked Mr. Damsell for repairing the granite posts which were hit by a car on Water Street. Mr. Damsell noted the pillars have shifted.

## 10. Next Meeting Dates

Chair Staples noted the next meeting is March $15^{\text {th }}$ and he will notify the other members where the meeting will be since they were not able to get the Novak Room for this meeting and some meetings are site walks. Chair Staples noted that at the All Board's Meeting it was discussed that the meeting schedule for the year should be submitted to Pam. The Trustees agreed regular meetings would be the third Wednesday of each month except for November when they open maintenance bids after Thanksgiving and there is no meeting in December typically. Chair Staples will let Pam know their planned schedule.

## 11. Adjourn

Mr. Thompson motioned to adjourn the meeting at 5:31 PM. Chair Staples seconded the motion. A vote was taken, all were in favor, the motion passed unanimously.
