7	1. Call Meeting to Order:
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9 10 11	Chair Staples called the meeting to order at 5:00 PM and introduced the members who were present
12	2. Introductions:
13 14 15	Present were: Chair Dwane Staples, Vice-Chair Darius Thompson, Dave Short and Select Board representative Niko Papakonstantis
16	3. Public Comment
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18 19 20 21 22	Chair Staples asked if there were any comments from the public. Mark Damsell expressed concerns with some lawns not being mowed and tidying up needed near construction areas. He noted the river side of the fence should be trimmed weekly or every other week. There are dead Winterberry and overgrown brush.
23 24 25 26 27 28	Chair Staples noted he walked the Parkway with Andy from Wright Pierce to target some areas. Mowing won't be done around construction signs. An email was sent concerning the Pump House lawn. Mr. Short will talk to John about trimming the spot by the entrance. He recommended the street sweeper make a pass to remove any debris and sediment along the curbing. Mr. Damsell indicated he saw the sweeper come the day before.
29 30 31 32	Florence Ruffner expressed concerns with traffic closure at the Water Street end. Chair Staples indicated there should be barriers put down by the Pavilion and signs. He noted a second siphon project is planned. Mr. Damsell noted he missed being able to drive on the Parkway.
33 34	Mr. Damsell thanked the Trustees for their service to the Town and the Trustees thanked Mr. Damsell for his assistance over the years.
35	4. Approve Minutes 7/19/23
36 37 38	Chair Staples motioned to approve the July 19, 2023 meeting minutes. Mr. Thompson seconded the motion. A vote was taken, all were in favor, the motion passed unanimously.
39 40	5. Arts and Culture Committee Presentation

- 41 Florence Ruffner and other members of the Arts & Culture Committee presented a proposal to
- donate a stone art sculpture by artist Joseph Gray, to the Parkway where it could prominently
- 43 be displayed. The Committee plans to have a tour of sculptures throughout Exeter.

- 44 Chair Staples expressed concerns with installing this sculpture when many have been turned
- 45 away who wanted a memorial bench. Ms. Ruffner asked if a different sculpture or location
- 46 would be suitable so that the Parkway could participate. Mr. Short recommended putting the
- 47 eagle sculpture by the entry gate where it could be seen by those entering the Parkway and
- 48 passersby. The Committee was receptive to that idea and the Trustees conveyed that they
- would be receptive to having a sculpture placed somewhere where a tree did not grow well and
 noted two potential areas by the pavilion and the flagpole once the Parkway has gotten past
- 50 noted two potential areas by the pavilion and the happo
 - 52 Mr. Thompson asked the size of the sculpture approx 5'8" x 36" sitting on two big stones. He
 - asked if it had any sharp edges it is rough stone but has no sharp edges. Mr. Thompson
 - 54 asked if the sculpture would be permanent yes.
 - 55 Select Board Representative Papakonstantis explained to the Committee the process for
 - submitting the proposal to the Town Manager and getting on the Select Board agenda to accept
 - 57 the donation and recommended having details about moving and installation. Ms. Ruffner will
 - discuss the location with Parks & Recreation also. The Trustees thanked the donor who was
 - 59 present at the meeting.

60 6. Update on no dog sign

- 61 Chair Staples reported that the Trustees decided they would like Mr. Thompson to make the no
- 62 dog stencil sign larger. Mr. Thompson explained what the stencil would look like when he
- 63 finished it and how it would be spraypainted, so it is visible in the two pathways at ground level.

7. Planting along fence behind Harris Center and Tree and Shrub Pruning

65 Mr. Short indicated the cost, approved at \$1,500, would be closer to \$1,000. Mr. Short will 66 contact the company to get started and let Jay know when work will commence.

67 *Mr.* Thompson motioned to authorize Mr. Short to contract the work with the vendor. 68 *Chair Staples seconded the motion. A vote was taken and passed unanimously.*

69 8. Sewer Project

- 70 Select Board Representative Papakonstantis reported on the special warrant article which
- 71 passed to approve the second siphon project. He reported that the first pipe was installed
- successfully and is testing well. He thanked the voters who came out to support the project and
- the Trustees for reporting on the work at their meetings and educating the public. He reported
- the second project should start in late fall and not interfere with the holiday parade but will report
- 75 back at the next meeting.

76 9. Tree Pruning

- 77
- The Trustees discussed trees that needed pruning and Chair Staples agreed to follow up with
- 79 Chris Kemp on the Emerald Ash Borer treatments. Injections have had some success.
- 80 Parasitic wasps are also being utilized to help younger growth trees. Mr. Thompson questioned
- 81 why not do both and it was noted that one could be done or the other but not both.
