25 26 27 28 29	Chair Staples asked about feedback since the no dog signs were placed. Mr. Short noted there were some negative comments on the community Facebook page. Chair Staples noted that some people brought their dogs to a recreation event. Mr. Thompson noted that the ordinance does not permit dogs in any of the town parks. Mr. Short indicated the Trustees have done all they can do.

32 33 34 35 36	Chair Staples reported that he forwarded the email he received at the beginning of the week regarding the meeting with the Select Board on November 20 <sup>th</sup> to discuss the turnaround. Mr. Thompson will be attending. Chair Staples noted he has a conflict but will try to attend. Mr. Short indicated he will try to be there as well and wondered if the Trustees could get a copy of any conceptual plans in advance.
37	7. Tree Donation
38 39 40	Chair Staples thanked Mr. Short for sighting and placing the tree. He indicated that the Trustees would welcome more donations as there are a few spots where trees have already been removed and other trees to be removed. The Trustees would have to approve of the

- 41 species depending on where the tree would be located. Mr. Thompson wondered if a list should
- 42 be made available. Mr. Short recommended waiting until someone offered to make a donation
- 43 and that the best avenue for that would be through the Tree Committee who are also soliciting
- 44 donations of trees.

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## 45 8. Planting along fence behind Harris Center and Tree and Shrub Pruning

- 46 Chair Staples indicated plantings will be selected for the spring and suggested planting a
- 47 Hydrangea by the fence.
- Chair Staples noted the Ash tree by the Block Building will need to come down. The area is wet
- 49 so it would be best to wait until the ground freezes.
- 50 Chair Staples asked about any safety issues and Mr. Short noted he walked the area with Will
- and a Birch by the Pump House has bad tops but that could be addressed between now and
- when construction resumes on December 11th. Mr. Short will contact Will.

## 9. Parkway Landscape maintenance bid

Chair Staples indicated the Trustees opened the bids earlier. There were three bids received and two were close but Jonathan was the lowest and they agreed to go with Jonathan again.

## 10. Other Business

Chair Staples reported that the turf by the Newfields side was treated for grubs by Biospray with Dylox and the starter fertilizer was applied. He noted the starter fertilizer has a low nitrogen content.

Mr. Thompson noted some plantings have grown together by the pavilion and Chair Staples recommended addressing that when the water bubbler is installed.

Chair Staples reported the irrigation was blow out and the leak repaired. Mr. Thompson questioned whether anything needed replacing and Chair Staples noted the clock did not work well. Mr. Short asked when the system was last run and Chair Staples noted two-three years ago when the overseeding was done. There was a drought last year and this year too much rain.

Chair Staples recommended a good maintenance program for the turf area by the pavilion which gets a lot of use.

Chair Staples noted the next meeting would be on January 17, 2024 at 5:00 PM.
