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- Mr. Thompson recommended the design conceptualizes not just the 100-year flood or 200-year but takes a look at the impact of 1000-year. Mr. Short noted the impact of sea level rise to the
- 62 Parkway impacts all the way to businesses on Water Street.

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Ms. Murphy referenced the CAPE study or Climate Action Plan for Exeter that was done in 2010 or 2012 and indicated she would like to re-engage. She noted there was some flagging and will send the link.

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## 7. Update on Turn Around and Input received from public

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Chair Staples asked if anyone had received feedback concerning the new turnaround. Mr. Thompson noted that he visited with his full-sized pick up truck and found it a little bit tight. He noted that prior to where the lines are marked is not wide enough for three cars.

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Chair Staples noted he received feedback about one challenge which was parking on the backside of the turnaround and being able to get around it.

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Chair Staples recommended being patient since the turnaround was just put in in November and adjustments could be made as necessary.

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Mr. Thompson indicated it was great to see reflective stickers on the gates.

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Chair Staples noted some trees were done in January and there will likely be more branches to clean up before the end of the winter.

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Mr. Short recommended getting information to John about the key. Chair Staples will reach out to him.
