7	1. Call Meeting to Order
8	
9	Chair Staples called the meeting to order at 5:00 PM and introduced the members who were
10	present
11	
12	2. Introductions:
13	Present were: Chair Dwane Staples, Vice-Chair Darius Thompson and Dave Short
14	
15	Others Present: Select Board Representative Papakonstantis
16	
17	3. Public Comment
18	
19	There was no public comment, outside of agenda items.
20	
21	4. Approval of Minutes
22	
23	June 18, 2025 Public Meeting Minutes
24	
25	Chair Staples recommended edits to lines 74 and 95.
26	
27	Mr. Thompson motioned to approve the June 18, 2025 minutes, as amended. Mr. Short
28	seconded the motion. A vote was taken, all were in favor, the motion passed
29	unanimously 3-0-0.
30	
31	Chair Staples noted there was no quorum on July 16, 2025.
32	
33	5. Swasey Trustee Bequest/Peter Lennon (remotely)
34	
35	Peter Lennon, Chair of the Trustee of Trust Funds gave a brief history of the \$50,000 bequest
36	from Ambrose Swasey in 1929 which was held by Key Bank for the construction and
37	maintenance of the parkway. He explained that the Select Board has the option to ask that the
38	funds be send to the Town of Exeter. He noted that the Trustees voted in favor of doing so and
39 40	he discussed the same with the Finance Director and would like input and support from the Swasey Parkway Trustees and for them to attend a Select Board meeting in October. He noted
40 41	that the initial \$50,000 has grown to \$300,000.
41	that the initial \$00,000 has grown to \$000,000.
43	Mr. Lennon provided benefits for the decision such as increased oversight, confidence in the
44	town's investment policy, avoiding high fees, consolidating the portfolio, and preservation of

45	principal. He noted that annual income is currently deposited into the Swasey Parkway
46	Maintenance account four times a year and that would continue to be done annually.
47	
48	Chair Staples questioned whether the account principal would be the \$50,000 or the \$300,000
49	and Mr. Lennon noted they could do both but the preference would be \$300,000.
50	
51	Mr. Lennon noted the benefit of the option of using \$50,000 would be in the event something
52	were planned on a large scale improvement but they did not know of any plans. Chair Staples
53	questioned what the Coastal Resiliency study may come back with.
54	
55	Mr. Short indicated that it makes sense.

Chair Staples asked if the public had questions or comments and there were none.

Chair Staples motioned to support the moving of current Swasey bequest from Key Bank to the Exeter Select Board for the recommendation of the Trustee of Trust Funds. Mr. Thompson seconded the motion. A vote was taken, all were in favor, the motion passed unanimously.

Select Board Representative Papakonstantis noted he will get them on the agenda for October.

6. Coastal Resiliency Update

Mr. Thompson noted the meeting is on September 15th.

7. Lawn Area in Front of Fence at Pump Station

Chair Staples noted that Piscataqua is doing the area of the lawn by the Pump Station. There will be a kickoff meeting on August 26th and he will attend that. They will be running temporary irrigation and he discussed that with Steve Dalton to have it cordoned off for hydroseeding. The plywood will be removed by Mr. Thompson this week.

8. Lock Box

Chair Staples reported that the Fire Chief is satisfied with the gate and noted that if someone forgets to put the key back in the lock box they will cut the lock.

9. Update on Turn Around – Input from Public

Mr. Thompson asked about the low spot and Chair Staples noted that they are looking at it and a decision has not been made.

10. Electric Budget

Select Board Representative Papakonstantis noted the draft budget is being put together.
