## 8. Tree Pruning and removal/Unitil recommendations

 Mr. Short reported that he met with Unitil representatives and had a walk yesterday from the triangle at Summer Street north to the big open field. Significant trees will be left alone, the large birch will be pruned and the large oak and another oak, they will limb the branches over the wires. They will remove shrub size under 12' and saplings in for about 10-15.' There are three or four large white pines that are a hazard to the main feeder lines and those will likely be removed.

## 9. Block Building

Chair Staples reported that he checked on the receptacles. The GFI was blown and he fixed that. He checked the inside breaker and shut that off and let Greg Bisson know, who indicated they don't use it. He noted the 2'x6' on the garage door to the left is kind of opened up and someone should look at it and fill in the left side. Mr. Thompson will take a look at it and touch up the paint.

# 10. Landscape Maintenance Bid Specifications

 Chair Staples recommended changing #3 mowing, as to weather permitting and eliminating Thursday. He noted the standard height is 2.5" and they could keep that or leave it up to the contractor. They will usually raise the height in the summer months. He indicated that he did not want to leave it up to the contractor whether to mow, or not, the Trustees should decide. The Bid Specifications will be put out in November. Mr. Thompson indicated he would take a look at it before the next meeting.

#### 11. Other Business

Chair Staples thanked the Tree Committee for their work and reported that the big birch is certified now to be the biggest in New Hampshire. Dave Martin is working with UNH on cataloguing. The Trustees can get a placard for the tree for \$20. Mr. Thompson recommended reaching out to ExeterTV. Chair Staples recommended involving the Tree Committee. Mr. Short noted they could do a segment on the Tree Committee. Chair Staples noted the tree had been chained off, air spaded and cabled. Chair Staples recommended bringing the photograph of the tree as a sapling. Mr. Thompson noted the gentleman who donated the chain offered more.

Mr. Short discussed the tree behind the Housing Authority that needs to come down, along with a small and large maple, and pruning for the oak trees. Chair Staples noted the ash tree and other trees with green ribbons. Mr. Thompson will look at those.

Chair Staples discussed the plum tree which was donated by a family in memory of their son who passed. Friends got together and replaced it the second time. The Trustees indicated they would replace it.
