Approved Minutes**

1. Call Meeting to Order

9 Chair Staples called the meeting to order at 4:00 PM and introduced the members who were
10 present

2. Open Landscape Maintenance Bids

14 Chair Staples opened the sealed bids and noted:

51 Chair Staples will take care of the brush pile at the Water Street entrance and the Hawthorn tree
52 that split.

54 Mr. Thompson noted all bids seem close by the one from ME.

56 Mr. Short noted that John is a known and does what he is asked. He noted My Leaf is \$100-
57 \$200 more, so it is pretty close. Mr. Thompson agreed.

59 ***Mr. Thompson motioned to proceed with All Natural Landscaping. Mr. Short seconded
the motion. A vote was taken, all were in favor, the motion passed unanimously.***

76 ***Mr. Thompson motioned to approve the October 15, 2025 minutes. Mr. Short seconded
the motion. A vote was taken, all were in favor, the motion passed unanimously 3-0-0.***

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78 **6. Coastal Resiliency Update**

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80 Mr. Thompson reported the next meeting is on December 1, 2025 at SST, 40 Linden Street from
81 6-8 PM and there will be public input and breakout sessions so the audience can participate.
82 He asked for permission to put a flyer in a couple of places at the Parkway.

84 ***Mr. Short motioned to allow the Coastal Resiliency Advertisement to be placed in the
Parkway as requested. Mr. Thompson seconded the motion. A vote was taken, all were
in favor, the motion passed unanimously 3-0-0.***

102 **9. Mroz Bench Bequest Terms**

104 The Trustees reviewed the bequest terms for the bench, marker and tree, and discussed how
105 they can be adhered to in the future. Mr. Short noted that it was a generous offer but the
106 interest alone would pay for the work and questioned if there were a way to utilize the funds on
107 a more significant scale while incorporating the memory of his son and continue to ensure the
108 work takes place. Mr. Short noted the surplus interest will continue to grow and he hates to see
109 it tied up doing nothing when more could be accomplished with it. Chair Staples recommended
110 going back and talking to Mr. Mroz. Select Board Chair Papakonstantis noted it was a generous
111 bequest and Mr. Mroz's choice. The Trustees noted they do not meet in December and could
112 have something final in January.

114 ***Mr. Thompson motioned to authorize Chair Staples to agree to the terms of the bequest
115 pending discussion with the donor as to whether there is a way to utilize the funds more
116 significantly while incorporating the memory of his son and continuing to ensure the
117 work takes place in perpetuity. Mr. Short seconded the motion. A vote was taken, all were
118 in favor, the motion passed unanimously.***

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124 Chair Staples reported that \$312,000 was received from Key Bank and that he met with Pat
