## **First Session**

You are hereby notified that the first session (the Deliberative Session) of the Special Town Meeting will be held on Tuesday, March 31<sup>st</sup>, 2015 beginning at 7:00 p.m. at the Exeter Town Hall, 9 Front Street. The first session will consist of explanation, discussion and debate of each of the following warrant articles, and will also afford voters who are present the opportunity to propose, debate and adopt amendments to warrant articles, except those articles in which wording is prescribed by state law.

## Second Session

The second session of the Special Town Meeting, to vote on all warrant articles as they may have been amended at the first session, will be held on April 28<sup>th</sup>, 2015 at the Talbot Gymnasium at the Tuck Learning Center, 30 Linden Street. Polls for voting by official ballot will open at 7:00 a.m. and close at 8:00 p.m.

<u>Article 1</u>: To see if the town will vote to discontinue absolutely Gilman Street as a public highway, including any utility easements, permits or licenses therein, said discontinuance of Gilman Street to take effect upon the execution and recording of an Agreement between the town and the Trustees of Phillips Exeter Academy to ensure public access for (1) vehicular access via Chadwick Lane to the Gilman Park footbridge located at the end of the present Gilman Street, (2) parking in the area of the Gilman Park footbridge, and (3) pedestrian and other non-motorized access to the Gilman Park footbridge by the Gilman Street area. The discontinuance of Gilman Street as a public highway will relieve the town of all future maintenance costs for Gilman Street.
